The 'I Do' Details

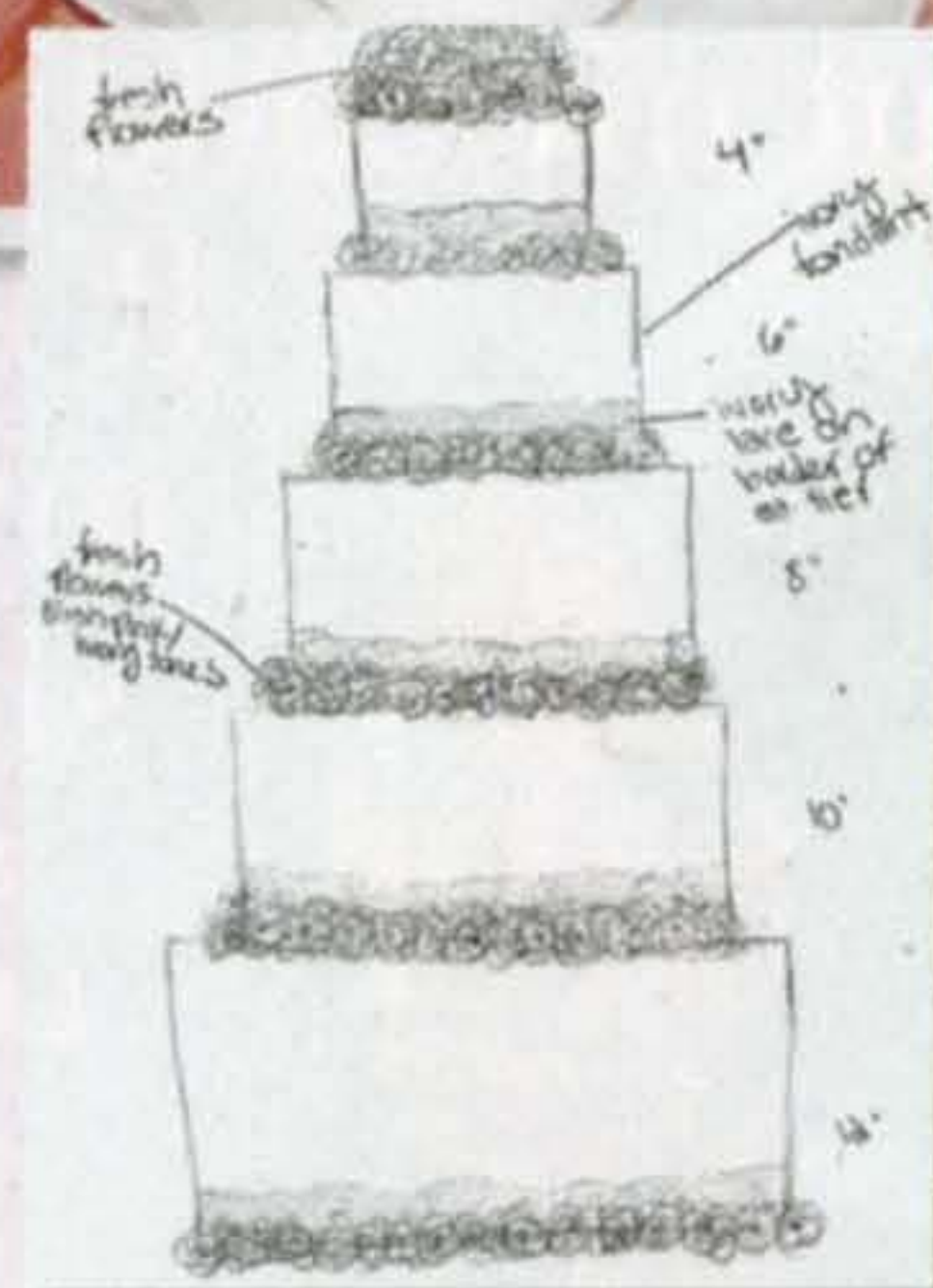
Flowers

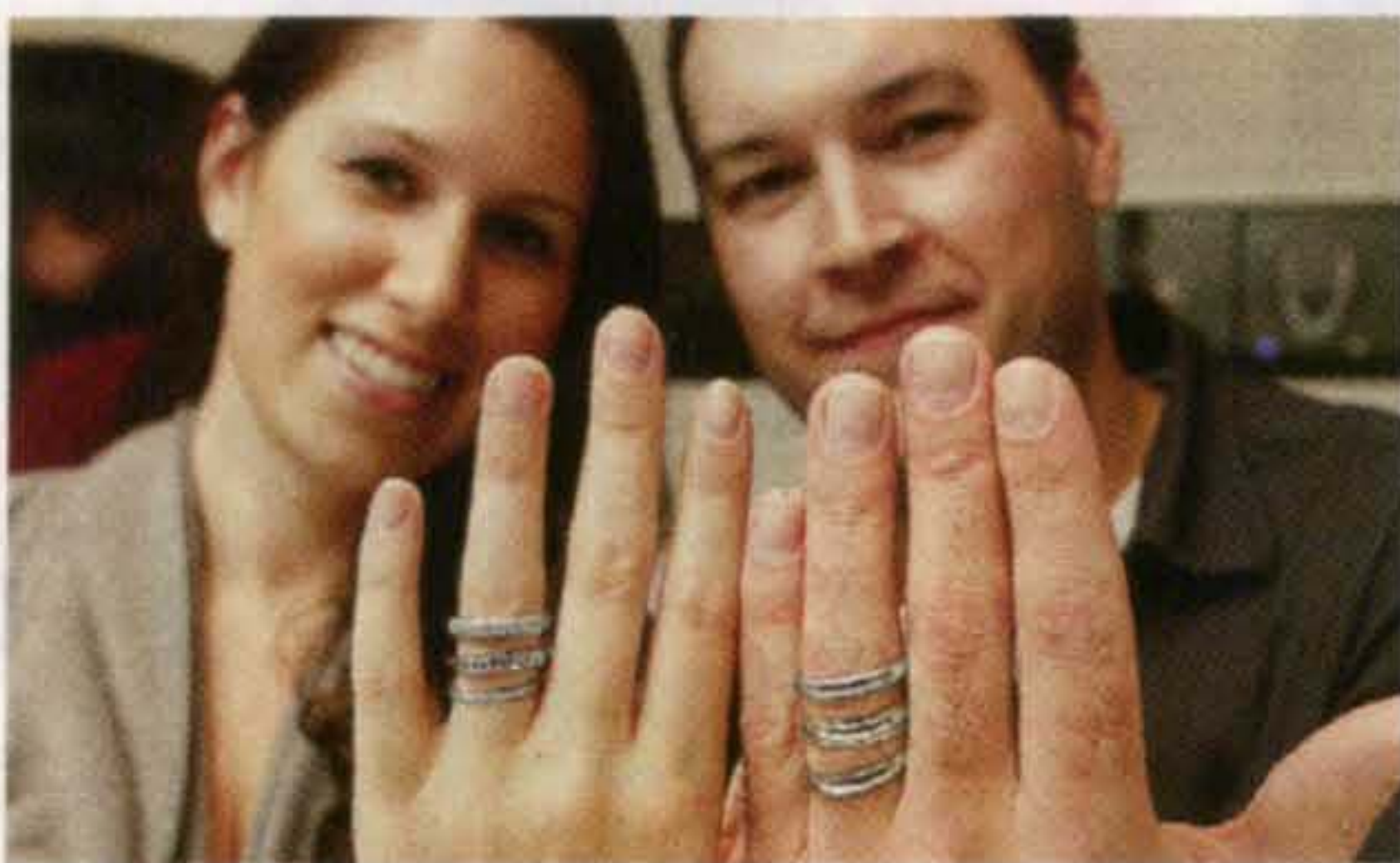
Cake
